

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **NEW DISTRIBUTION DATES set for “SENIOR FARMERS MARKET VOUCHER PROGRAM”**

The Division of Aging & Disability Services has set new distribution dates for the Warren County “Senior Farmers Market Voucher Program” (SFMVP). Seniors who were unable to pick-up their vouchers on the original 2011 distribution dates (July 11<sup>th</sup> – July 15) have another opportunity to receive their vouchers.

Warren County has been awarded 1000 sets of \$20.00 vouchers to distribute to **1000 county seniors** who meet program guidelines. Vouchers can be used to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs grown by NJ authorized farmers from June 1<sup>st</sup>, to Nov 30, 2011.

To be eligible for the program, a Warren County resident must be 60 or older and have an income below **\$20,147 if single** or **\$27,214 for a couple**.

Seniors may pick-up their vouchers from any distribution site, but **ONLY** on the dates and times of the scheduled distribution. To reduce any wait period, seniors are strongly encouraged to bring all necessary documentation to the distribution, along with the completed application.
