



LANDFILL DIRECTIONS

Route 78 - Take Route 78 to Route 31 North. When you reach the town of Washington, cross over Route 57 and continue for approximately 6-7 miles. You will see a sign on the right side of the road that reads "Warren County Resource Recovery Facility". One-tenth of a mile on the left you will see an access road. The sign will read Covanta Energy. Make a left onto the access road and keep to the left at the Y in the road. At the Stop sign make a right (Mt. Pisgah Ave.) and follow into the Landfill.

Route 80 - Take Route 80 to Route 46E. Follow Rt. 46 until you come to the Junction of Route 31. Turn onto Rt. 31 South. Approximately one mile on the right you will come to an access road. Follow directions from above.

TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP

TOWNSHIP PROPERTY OWNERS:

The Liberty Township Clean-up will run 15 – 20 October 2012.

A voucher system will be used. Each voucher entitles residents to bring (1) one vehicle (car or pick-up size load) to the Warren County Landfill in Oxford, N.J., Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 2:30 pm and Saturday from 7:00am to 11:00am. All homeowners are entitled to (1) one voucher. Only residential property owners are entitled to receive these vouchers. Vouchers are not issued for commercial properties. You may pick up your voucher beginning 1 October 2012. Bring proof of residency to the Municipal Building during regular business hours. **EACH VOUCHER MUST CONTAIN THE RAISED SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY. PHOTO COPIES OF THE VOUCHER WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

PERSONS REQUIRING ASSISTANCE:

Property owners with disabilities may call the Township 908.637.4579 to arrange for pick-up. This assistance collection day will be conducted "ONLY" on 18 October 2012.



WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE LANDFILL:

When you arrive at the scale house, you will drive on the scale to be weighed. The attendant will take your voucher and confirm residency and then direct you to the dumping area.

Drive to the designated area where you will unload your own vehicle. **EACH VOUCHER MUST CONTAIN THE RAISED SEAL OF THE MUNICIPALITY. PHOTO COPIES OF THE VOUCHER WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

Children **MUST** remain in vehicles at all times. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

Return to the scale to be weighed out.

WHAT YOU CANNOT BRING:



- Hazardous waste
- Truck or auto parts
- Household batteries
- Auto batteries
- Explosives
- Drums of any size
- Asbestos
- Pesticides
- Liquid wastes
- Gasoline
- Paints (of any kind)
- Computers or other electronics
- Tires

WHAT YOU CAN BRING:

- Household junk
- Furniture
- Scrap metal
- Wood
- Lawn mowers (with all fluids removed)
- Appliances (washers, dryers, dishwashers, etc.)



NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOWNSHIP CLEAN-UP: Freon-containing appliances, such as air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers. However, the landfill will accept these items for a **\$15.00 CHARGE** (per item). Doors must be removed.
