NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM – COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE VISIT An email was received 7 August 2025 from Scott Ulrick, Division of Resilience Engineer and Construction, NJDEP. This letter inquired into the status of the Liberty Township Corrective Action and Compliance Plan regarding Community Assistance Visit held 5 March 2024 with Liberty Township. John Inscho reported that he had spoken with Eric Snyder, Municipal Planner, and they would address the National Flood Insurance Program when Eric returns to New Jersey in September 2025.

WHEREAS, the real property known as Block 42, Lot 7 on the Tax Map of the Township of Liberty, is owned by a Veteran who has been determined to be 100% wartime service-connected disabled by the United States Veteran's Administration; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NJSA 54:44-3.30, any such disabled Veteran is entitled to tax exempt status for their home; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has no administration procedure available to make the property tax exempt prior to creating the 2025 calendar year tax duplicate; and

WHEREAS, action is required by the Township Committee to provide the lawful tax exemption for Block 11, Lot 42.21;

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Township Committee of the Township of Liberty as follows;

- 1. Pursuant to NJSA 54:4-3.30, the premises at Block 42, Lot 7 are hereby made tax exempt as of 1 January 2025 while under the ownership of Dustin and Daniele Nevins.
