## MINUTES LIBERTY TOWNSHIP LAND USE BOARD 18 October 2023

The Liberty Township Land Use Board meeting of 16 August 2023 was opened at 7:30 by Vice-Chairman Kevin Wulf. The Vice-Chairman read the Open Public Meetings Act statement.
