PETITION FOR MUNICIPAL FRANCHISE

TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIBERTY

Petitioner, Elizabethtown Gas Company ("Elizabethtown" or "Petitioner"), a public utility corporation of the State of New Jersey respectfully shows:

- 1. Petitioner is a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, and is a public utility engaged in distribution of natural and mixed gas, subject to the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("NJBPU" or "the Board"). The principal business office of the petitioner is 520 Green Lane, Union, NJ 07083.

- 3. Petitioner is engaged in the business of transmitting and distributing natural and mixed gas to approximately 315,000 customers within its service area located principally in Sussex, Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Morris, Union and Warren Counties.
- 4. Some property owners in Township of Liberty, in the County of Warren, New Jersey have been served or would like to be served with gas by Elizabethtown.
 - 5. Elizabethtown currently serves other communities within Warren County.
- 6. Elizabethtown respectfully requests permission to have a municipal franchise in Liberty Township so that Elizabethtown can serve both its existing customers and future customers in Liberty Township.
 - 7. The form of Ordinance annexed hereto as Schedule A has been submitted to the Honorable

Mayor and Township Committee for their consideration. By the terms of such Ordinance, Elizabethtown

would agree to restore at its own expense all such streets, avenues, parks, parkways, highways, sidewalks,

grass plots, curbs or other public place to their pre-existing condition at the commencement of any work

performed by Elizabethtown; said work shall be done in a careful, prudent and workmanlike manner and

within such a time as shall be best for the proper restoration thereof.

8. Elizabethtown would agree to give notice to the Township Committee or its duly

authorized officials, of its intentions to open or excavate a street or other public place as aforesaid, and

would agree to abide by any Ordinance now existing or hereafter passed which regulates the excavation

and opening of streets, roads or highways.

9. The work of laying or repairing gas mains and/or distribution lines and laterals shall be

done by the Company in a careful, prudent and workmanlike manner at its own expense.

10. Elizabethtown would, at all times, protect and save harmless the Township of Liberty

from any and all damages to person or property and from any and all actions, costs or claims which

may be caused by or out of, relate to or result from the Company's negligence in construction, laying,

repairing, inspecting, altering or maintaining of mains, conductors, pipes and appurtenances thereto.

11. Elizabethtown would agree to execute and file with the Clerk of the Township its bond in

the penal sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars in satisfactory form, guaranteeing its performance of

the conditions of the Ordinance which Bond may be enlarged or renewed from time to time as the Township

Committee may require.

12. Upon approval of the within Ordinance by the Township of Liberty, Petitioner will submit

said Ordinance to the NJBPU for approval.
